

Once you begin making contributions to a retirement plan you will want to watch your account grow. You will want to monitor your account to be sure all expected deposits are made to your account. You will also want to monitor the investments that you have selected to be sure the performance meets your expectations. In addition, by regularly monitoring your account, you will be better able to make investment changes from time to time to meet your long term goals.

The plan website has several tools that will help you with this monitoring process. The website address to access your account is the following: <https://www.retirementaccountlogin.com/oriental/sponsor.aspx>. Login consists of an individual user name and personalized password. Your initial user ID is your social security number (no dashes) and the initial password will be the last four digits of your social security number. The first time you login you will be required to personalize your user name and password to your liking.

Once you gain access to your account, the landing page will be a summary of your account. You will see your account display by money type and by investment option. This will provide a quick snap shot of your account.

To dig deeper, you should navigate the top menu bar to the Investment tab. This tab contains detailed information concerning the investment options available in the plan, including fund fact sheets. The fact sheets provide a consistent format for comparing fund objective, performance and fees.

The Investment tab also has a performance option that displays your personal account performance over the past month, quarter or year. You may also use the Custom tab to calculate your rate of return for your account over any selected period of time.
